- Ex. Level 4 gymnast that qualify's in Fall can use that score in Level 4 Spring State Championship
- Ex. Level 4 gymnast gets State Level 4 qualifying scores and competes also as Level 5 in Fall then enters Level 4 Fall State Championship, MUST receive a Level 5 score after Level 4 Fall State Championship to Compete in the Level 5 Spring State Championship
